To start or finish your holiday or **both**, a reef trip is a must. Try to go with the "A" Team and Keetie (Mr. Tobago). If you can't go with him try Sammy's trip, any problems see Jerry. The trip costs about £35.00 but it's a full day out with all you can eat and drink. First you go to the reef for a snorkel, then to the Coral Garden to look at the fish and coral. After this it's a quick relaxing swim in Nylon Pool, finishing with your barbecue on No Mans Land. **You've not been to Tobago unless you've been to No Mans Land**.

All our kitchens are fully equipped including fridge, microwave's, kettle's and toaster's. Each apartment has television and air con. We are situated only 10 mins. From the Airport at Crown Point and only 5 mins. from the capital at Scarborough.

Don't bother with travellers cheques use your credit cards !! There is a blue machine (CASH machine) at the bank and at the airport but it is always very busy so it's best to go to Penny Savers (the BEST super market on Tobago) to use your cards. Penny savers is half way between us and the airport. There are blue machines in Scarborough, just check the banks. DON'T forget your **PIN No.** The local currency is "TT" Dollars and varies from 7 to 9 to the £ sterling. If you like wine I would suggest you bring your FULL ALLOWANCE as it's very expensive in Tobago, where as spirits are the same price, if not cheaper, than the U.K. There is a good wholesaler in Scarborough just ask Jerry. We are within yards of the beach and have a beautiful warm and safe lagoon for swimming, though it



is advisable to wear plimsolls as dead coral can often be washed up. The view from the apartments.

Nearly all of the hotels entertain their guests every night but it is quite acceptable for you to join in. The drinks can be pricey, stick to the local beers and rum. Please do not be afraid of using the local rum shacks, as the prices there are most agreeable. Coco Reef Hotel is one to miss unless you've just robbed a bank. A rum and coke is tt. 32 which is more than half a bottle of rum. The Copra Tray on a Saturday night is where they have the African Drums playing, they are great, and the atmosphere is brilliant. They start at 10.00 pm, but check, just Sunday nights will never be the same again once you've been to Sunday school at Bucco. It starts at 9.00pm. With the steel band but to be honest we never get there till 11.30pm. There are lots of local stalls selling various hot and cold foods and one big disco, which takes over the whole village. Wednesday night is local talent night at The Gold Star (near the airport). It's a bit tacky but can be fun if you mix with the locals, there again, in Tobago you'll always have a good time if you mix with the locals!!! The Green Light Bar starts at 10.00pm. and has music and dancing for all ages, it's prices are excellent.



Mount Ervine Beach In our opinion, the best beach is 10 mins. away by car at Mount Irvine Bay. With in 10 yards is a reef with brilliant snorkelling or you can hire water sports equipment from the shop. Take a picnic or just booze no one can stop you. Some places try to say their beach is private but there are NO private beaches on the island. Pigeon Point is a must but it can be a bit touristy. You will have to pay to drive down the road but if you walk down the beach it's free of charge (no matter what the guards say). Store Bay has the most modern shops etc. but it's also the dearest. Alwavs Remember BARTER.
